Volunteer Beneficiary Application & Instructions

Thank you for your interest in volunteering for the 2026 First Peoples Tri-State Wing-Off. The upcoming event will be held on Friday, June 19th & Saturday, June 20th, 2026. As last year, we are opening the volunteer opportunities up to large groups initially. Anything that is not spoken for beyond the Large Group Volunteer Deadline will be made available for smaller groups to fill in. As a reminder, you're signing up for the entire day for one particular job. You will be responsible for providing the necessary staff for all shifts that are required. Groups have until March 6, 2026 to claim a full day station. However please keep in mind that it is on a first come, first served basis, and it is not recommended to wait if there is a specific task that you'd want. After the deadline, the remaining jobs will be broken down into smaller shifts and be filled by other volunteer organizations. Decisions on job assignments will be based on a variety of factors (submission date and performance in the position from previous year(s) will be considered).

Spokesperson: Each group should assign a spokesperson, who is responsible for the scheduling and overseeing of their chosen station(s). This person is responsible for:

- All communication with Wing-Off staff.
- Turning in all names of volunteers and shirt sizes no later than Friday, April 10, 2026. **Must be completed and turned in on the provided form (linked in volunteer section of Wing-Off website)**.
- Scheduling of their volunteers
- Ensuring the required number of volunteers per shift is being maintained at all times.
- Arranging a break for their volunteers, if necessary- while maintaining required staffing.

• Meeting at the Merch Tent on the day of the event to receive your donation (specific meeting time will be given to you at the volunteer meeting on June 9)). If the spokesperson is unable to attend, someone may be sent in their place.

Failure to meet the above requirements may result in deduction of payout, and ineligibility to volunteer for future events.
